Liverpool Football Club has received an allocation of 10,236 tickets for this ALL ticket fixture. Within the allocation of tickets received approximately 17% of the tickets are priced at £128, 25% are priced at £85, 41% are priced at £64, 17% are priced at £35.50.

Included within the allocation of tickets are a small number of restricted in view seats. These seats carry a 20% reduction of the full price.

There are no concessionary prices available for this game.

All tickets will be made available on a first come first serve basis and we cannot guarantee that the price of ticket you wish to purchase will be available at the time of booking.

We have also received an allocation of 24 Wheelchair disabled tickets. Tickets are priced at £35.50 and include 1 complimentary Personal Assistant ticket for each ticket purchased. Ambulant disabled tickets are also available.

Tickets will be issued on a 1:1 basis only.

Sale 2 - Ballot

A ballot registration period will be available for Season Ticket Holders, Members and Fan Card Holders who have recorded 7 Europa League Cup matches during season 2015/16. Once the registration period has ended a ballot will be run independently by the Electoral Reform Service. If entering the ballot for a junior supporter, it is important that you tick the relevant box on the registration form.

- The accompanying adult must also have registered their interest for a ticket via the ballot, although do not need to have been successful.
- The ticket must be purchased by the adult you've purchased tickets with during the 2015/16 Europa League Cup competition.
